General Rules

The deadline for entries is September 17, 2024.

The Jury is composed of eminent personalities from the world of International Music.

All musicians of any nationality and gender can participate in Music in the World with reference to the sections and categories indicated below:

Art. 4 - EXECUTION PROGRAMME

Youth Section

Free-choice programme with a minimum duration of 2 minutes and a maximum of 12 minutes; it must be a programme that highlights the young performer's talents and musical sensitivity.

Section No age limit

Free choice programme lasting a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 15 minutes; the programme must highlight the performer's musical skills and sensitivity.

Solo Singing

Free choice programme of 2 (two) pieces with a maximum total duration of 15 minutes

Solo Instrument

Free choice programme with a maximum total duration of 30 minutes

Choir and Chamber Groups

Free choice programme of a maximum total duration of 30 minutes

Creation and Performance of Contemporary Music

Free choice programme of a maximum total duration of 20 minute

Traditional national musical instruments of the world

Free choice programme of a maximum total duration of 30 minutes

Traditional folk vocal music from around the world

Free choice programme of a maximum total duration of 30 minutes

Art. 5 - SPECIAL PRIZE FOR PIANO "MAGNOLI ARTE"

It competes with the performance of two pieces chosen ones taken from the 10 Studies op.7 by Leonardo Saraceni (Ed. Magnoli Arte. 2002. Preface by Marcella Crudeli)

Art. 6 - SELECTION

The SELECTIONS will take place in two distinct stages:

- 1) listening by the commission of the pieces sent on the platform at the time of registration. (The audio or video files must be detached, i.e. in independent files, not in a single file)
- 2) live performances in Rome on October 26, 2024

Art. 7 - REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

- 1. Registration form
- 2. Copy of the receipt of payment of the participation fee
- 3. Copy of Identity Document
- 4. Two artistic photographs

Art. 8 - METHOD OF SENDING THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Performance files must be sent individually, NO in a single file, but in detached files
- Photographs must be suitable for publication on the Web and suitable for inclusion in theatre programmes
- All documents must be scanned and sent in .PDF format

Art. 9 - RECOGNISATION FOR TEACHERS

The teacher with the highest number of prize-winners will be awarded a Diploma of Honour and also appointed as a Jury Member for the next edition of the Competition.

- The Court of Castrovillari (CS Italy) shall have jurisdiction over any dispute.
